January Spotlight...**Welcome Home!**




I request that you please continue to pray for guidance, wisdom, strength and the Lord's continued blessings as we march forward in our transitions.

February 21 & 23, 2017	Rehabilitation (Short Term Stay) Households Open


Warmth of a Household Fireplace
