### March spotlight... **Short-Term Stay Rehabilitation Center!**

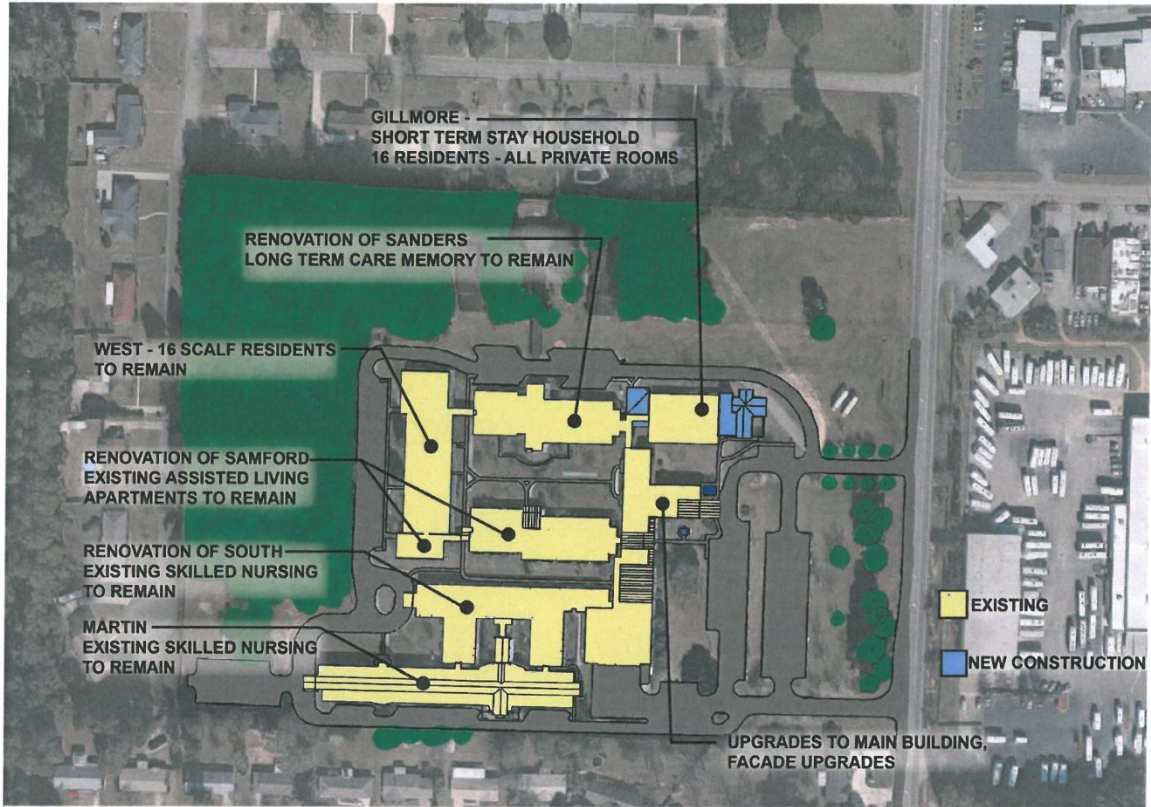
The area currently known as Gillmore Hall has been the home of numerous functions through the years, from an assisted living area to, most recently, an administrative and education center. With these functions being relocated elsewhere within the existing campus, this area will now be transitioned into a state-of-the-art household model skilled nursing short-term stay rehabilitation center with 16 private residential rooms with private baths! In addition to a complete interior rebuilding, two new additions will be made a part of this rehabilitation center, a physical and occupational therapy gym, and a household area for residents and associates. The household area will contain a living room, den, dining room, kitchen and other areas, all of which are designed to provide a home-like atmosphere for residents instead of a typical institutional nursing environment. I have included a photograph on the reverse side of a typical household area similar to that which our rehabilitation center will feature. What a difference this will create in the lives of our residents!

With construction now fully underway, we are able to project that the rehabilitation center will be completed by the end of this coming September. All construction should be complete by the end of January, 2017, weather permitting.
